

About Best Start Kindergarten Assessment

Best Start Kindergarten
Assessment is a state-wide
assessment that helps teachers
identify the literacy and numeracy
skills of each student at the
beginning of Kindergarten.





Assessment



The Best Start Kindergarten Assessment is designed to identify early literacy and numeracy skills and concepts.

The assessment is not a test and no preparation is required.

The teacher will ask a series of questions to gather information about your child and record their responses.

BEST START INFORMATION – LISA MILLER

Best Start Kindergarten Assessment - Literacy

The literacy assessment tasks are designed to identify your child's literacy skills, such as:

- recognising familiar words;
- identifying sounds and letters;
- · writing their own name; and
- understanding how books work.



Best Start Kindergarten Assessment - Numeracy

The numeracy assessment tasks are designed to identify how well your child can count; which numbers they recognise; and whether they can add or subtract small numbers.



BEST START INFORMATION – LISA MILLER

- The assessment takes about **20minutes to complete**.
- Parents will be required to book a time to do the assessment.
- Steps to book an assessment will be emailed to parents after class groups have been formed.
- The assessments will take place on the first three days of the school year:
- Friday 29th January

Monday 1st February

Tuesday 2nd February


- Parents wait outside the room whilst the assessment takes place.
- OOSH minding facilities are available for those first three days of school.
- Kindergarten students start on Wednesday 3rd February.



ORGANISATION FOR FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL - LISA MILLER

- We will notify parents as we are provided with updates from the Department of Education.
- Kindergarten students start on Wednesday 3rd February at 9:30am
- Children will be placed into classes and allocated a colour.
- Parents will drop their child off to the classroom (this will depend on Covid-19 restrictions)
- Parents will pick their child up from the Kindergarten area at 2:45pm. They will finish school at
 2:45pm for their first week and from 3pm onwards after that.
- What to bring:
- Students will require morning tea, lunch and a piece of fruit for their fruit break in the morning.
- Hat
- Water bottle (they cannot drink from the bubblers but can fill their bottles)
- What not to bring:
- Toys
- Valuables including money for the canteen
- Too much food
